

Summer Reading / Math Program and Auction
2010 - 2011
For Students Entering 2nd through 6th

All JCDS students presently in grades 1-5 (entering 2nd through 6th in the fall) are required to do summer reading. To help motivate, encourage and reward the students for their efforts, we have developed the reading auction program that is outlined below.

1. Students and parents will choose one prize that they would like to work toward from the attached list.
2. Fill out the contract below and send it back to school by May 21, 2010. The total points earned will be the total number of pages read.
3. Required reading for students entering grades 2 & 3 depend on the prize they contract for. Students entering grades 4 - 6 have the following reading requirements:
 - 4th grade - 800 points
 - 5th grade- 900 points
 - 6th grade-1000 points
4. Students may earn 300 points each by completing the Summer Math Skills Sharpener and the Summer Language Arts Review. Parents must send back a form or note verifying that their student has completed the book(s) when they turn in their reports. The actual skills booklets need to be turned into their homeroom teacher.
5. Students entering grades 3 - 6 are required to complete the Math Skills booklet and turn the booklet in to their homeroom teacher in the fall. When ordering, make sure to order the book that corresponds to the grade your child just finished. (Students finishing 2nd grade will order a 2nd grade book, and so on). You can no longer order books through JCDS. You may visit www.summerskills.com to order.
6. Challenging math problems will be placed on our website each week over the summer worth a total of 100 points. Children must show ALL work and complete ALL problems to receive the points.
7. As the students read over the summer they will also write a book report for each book read. These book reports are due August 25, 2010. Students who do not turn in their book reports on time will not participate in the reading celebration.
8. Students entering grades 4-6 who do not turn in their summer reading reports will have a zero averaged in with their reading grade for the first trimester.
9. A suggested list of books, book report form and the verification form for Math/LA book will be posted on our website. You may copy these forms or computer generate your own.
10. On September 24, 2010 we will have a school-wide Celebration and all students who have met their requirements will participate in their chosen, contracted activity.
11. The top readers in each grade level will be recognized at an assembly and special prizes will be awarded to them. Those who read beyond their contracted number will also be rewarded for their extra effort. All summer reading and math requirements are due August 25, 2010.
