

Summer Reading / Math Program and Auction  
2011 - 2012  
For Students Entering 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>

All JCDS students presently in grades 1-5 (entering 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> in the fall) are required to do summer reading. To help motivate, encourage, and reward the students for their efforts, we have developed the reading auction program that is outlined below.

1. Students and parents will choose one prize that they would like to work toward from the attached list.
2. Fill out the contract below, and send it back to school by May 20, 2011. The total points earned will be the total number of pages read.

Minimum Required Points:            2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade- 400 points  
    4th grade - 800 points  
    5th grade- 900 points  
    6th grade- 1000 points

3. Students may earn 300 points each by completing the required Singapore Summer Math booklets and the Summer Language Arts Reviews. Parents must send back a form or note verifying that their students have completed the book when they turn in their reports. The actual booklets need to be turned into the homeroom teacher.
4. As the students read over the summer, they will also write a book report for each book read. These book reports are due August 23, 2011. Students who do not turn in their book reports on time will not participate in the reading celebration.
5. Students entering grades 4-6 who do not turn in their summer reading reports will have a zero averaged in with their reading grade for the first trimester.
6. Suggested lists of books, book report forms, and the verification forms for Singapore Math/LA books will be posted on our website in early June. You may copy these forms or computer generate your own.
7. On September 23, 2011, we will have a school-wide celebration, and all students who have met their requirements will participate in their chosen, contracted activity.
8. The top readers in each grade level will be recognized at an assembly and awarded special prizes. Those who read beyond their contracted number will also be rewarded for their extra effort. All summer reading and math requirements are due August 23, 2011.
